Support at Home

Here are some things you can practice at home with your child:

In Math:

- rote counting by: 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s to 100
- practice printing numbers from 0 to 20
- associating numbers to 30 with matching quantities
- playing dominoes, recognizing the quantities/number by looking at the dots without counting them one by one
- add numbers to 5, use manipulatives, write out simple equations ($2 + 1 = 3$)

In Reading and Writing:

- while reading a story, practice tracking the text with your finger
- look for familiar words or letters in everyday environments (cereal boxes, shopping lists, street names, etc.)
- listen for beginning sounds in familiar words
- practice spelling words using letter sounds
- make lists / booklets of words your child knows starting with a specific sound, have him / her illustrate the words
- practice printing first and last name using upper and lower case letters


