

February Theme:

Family and Friends

Valentine's Day is the perfect celebration for our theme this month, as we discuss what it means to be a good friend and part of a family. Story time, math activities and crafts will all be centered around this friendly theme.



Support at Home

Here are some things you can practice at home with your child:

In Math:

-sorting objects and having your child tell you what rules they applied to sort them (color, shape, size, texture, etc.)

-associating numbers to 15 with matching quantities In Reading and Writing:

in Reduing and writing:

-when reading stories, practice tracking the text with your finger

- -listen for beginning sounds in familiar words
- -find words starting with those sounds

Sight Words:

We have just begun to learn sight words in class. These are high frequency words that are not always easy to sound out as many of them break the rules. (said, the etc...) You may have noticed a set of our first five words was sent home last Friday. You are invited to cut out the words to play (practice) a variety of games that are explained on the orange sheet that was sent with them. Each Friday I will send a new list of words that we have been learning in class for you to cut out and add to your collection. Keep the practice short and fun and only work with 10 words at a time. You will know your child has mastered the sight words when they can recognize the word within 2-3 seconds.

Parent Reading

Originally I had planned to have the Parent Reading on Friday February 26th. That is not going to work as we will be having our Harmony Day assembly during that time of the day. I am hoping to have the Parent Read on Thursday February 25th instead. If that does not work for the parents that have said they would read in the class please let me know

as we may have to cancel the February Parent Read.
